Data Accuracy and Completeness

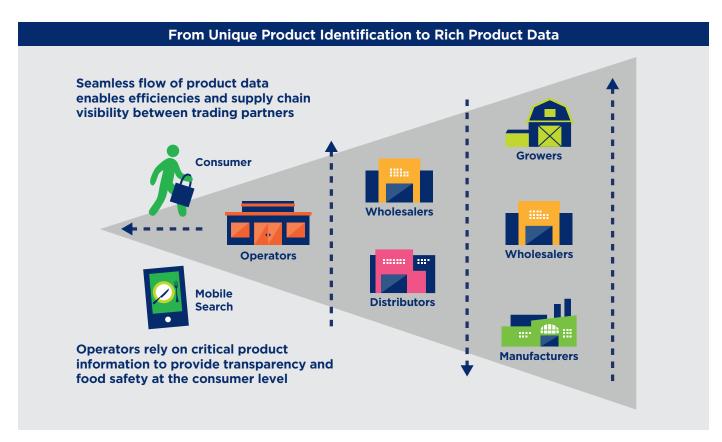
